Crash Checklist



CRASH CHECKLIST



Stay at the scene of the accident.

Leaving the scene right away can result in criminal hit-and-run charges.



Describe the scene:



Check for injuries.

Make sure everyone involved in the crash is alright. If necessary, call 911. If you believe someone has suffered head, neck, or back injuries, don't move that person. Leave them where they are until medical personnel arrive.



Describe your injuries:



Get out of the way of danger.

Move everyone off to the side of the road so that passing cars won't hit them. Put up your emergency triangle to warn passing cars about the wreck.



Call the police.

If you haven't already called 911 for medical attention, decide whether you need to call the police. You can deal with a fender bender yourself, but you need to call the police if anyone is hurt or if there is serious property damage. The non-emergency police number in Dayton, Ohio is (937) 333-COPS (2677).

Document the damage.

Use your cell phone to take detailed pictures of any damage to your car, any other cars, and any other property. You should also take pictures of the positions of the cars. Your insurance company and law enforcement may need those pictures to determine who is at fault.
